Parents of SJS Kids

Make sure that your student has the tools available to them for the following

school year.

Your child may be entitled to an Individual Education Plan. (IEP) or 504 Plan

This should be arranged immediately at the beginning of the new school year.

Depending on side effects your child may experience plans should include:

- Frequent bathroom breaks
- Preferential seating at the front of the classroom
- Permission to wear Sunglasses and hat
- Excused absences for medical treatment or illness
- Staff should be trained to handle any medications your child may need.
- Excused from strenuous activity

If your child suffers ocular damage they are entitled to a **Para Professional** to assist them with their studies as well as **a (TVI) teacher of the visually impaired**.

• Enlarged print and raised paper, large print text books, and mobility and Braille lessons.

All accommodations should be outlined in the IEP report and **MUST** be followed by the school.

Immediately address any bullying issues against your child and keep a record of these events.

Meet with the administrative team of your school district including school superintend should bullying

issues arise.
